RULES FOR TEACHERS

- Commitment to the classes is essential to be a Balavikas teacher. Regularity and punctuality are essential. If the teacher is late or unable to come he/she should inform the Balavikas coordinator and make necessary arrangement for an alternate teacher.
- We encourage teachers to wear Indian clothes. Teachers will set a good example of discipline and moral values taught to the children in Balavikas. No controversial material will be permitted in classes.
- Teachers have to be present for the whole duration of the Balavikas, thus increasing their availability. This will also help all teachers to know the program as a whole rather than only their part.
- Teachers are responsible to report any problem, behavioral or other, to the Balavikas coordinator, and/or Board representative. Teachers shall not take disciplinary action on the children.
- All teachers will complete a Teacher Volunteer form as prescribed by the temple. A lesson plan will be formulated and given to the Board representative.
- Teachers shall attend at least one workshop in a year as prescribed by the Board.
- Teachers will follow all the rules prescribed by the HTSA Board. The Board will review the rules on a regular basis and will revise them as needed.
